Special Election of February 9, 2016  
Report to the Canvassing Board at Certification

1. The equipment used to tabulate the ballots consists of HART software and Kodak Scanners. This system is certified for use in Washington State by the Secretary of State. The programming for this election was done by the Elections Division. A logic and accuracy test was performed.
2. All ballots were stored and locked in a secure area, both prior to the election and afterward.
3. All absentee ballots were processed according to statute. Experienced staff verified all signatures.
4. All ballots believed eligible for counting have been counted (10,383).
5. No system problems were encountered.
6. Results were reviewed for anomalies.
7. Ballots brought to the attention of the canvassing board included ballots with no signatures, mismatched signatures, ballots received after the election was closed, envelopes containing multiple ballots, and late postmarks.
8. Ballot count reconciliations were performed throughout the process to insure that all ballots received have been accounted for.
