




Primary Election – August 2, 2016
Report to the Canvassing Board
Recount of Precinct Committee Officer, Precinct 352

1. As the votes were tied at 66 for the Precinct Committee Officer position for precinct 352, as required by RCW 29A.64.021, a mandatory manual recount was conducted.
2. All ballots were stored and locked in a secure area, both prior to the election and afterward.
3. All ballots submitted for precinct 352 were accounted for.
4. The ballots were manually sorted into stacks (candidate a, candidate b and undervotes).
5. The stacks of ballots for each candidate were reviewed.
6. One ballot for candidate b was found to contain a mark which appears to be a stray mark, based on the standards set forth by the Office of the Secretary of State.
7. The determination of the stray mark gave the final count as:

Candidate A (Kimberly Dailey)	66 votes
Candidate B (Marjorie McNae)	65 votes
Undervotes	337
Total ballots cast	468
8. Ballot count reconciliations were performed throughout the process to insure that all ballots received have been accounted for.
