<p>Federal/State/Local/Tribal/Private Sector & Nongovernmental personnel to include:</p> <p><i>Required:</i> Command and general staff, select department heads with multi-agency coordination system responsibilities, area commanders, emergency managers, and;</p> <p><i>Recommended:</i> Emergency operations center managers.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ICS-100: Introduction to ICS or equivalent • ICS-200: Basic ICS or equivalent • ICS-300: Intermediate ICS or equivalent • ICS-400: Advanced ICS or equivalent • FEMA IS-700: NIMS, An Introduction • FEMA IS-800.A: National Response Plan (NRP), An Introduction*

* NOTE: Not all persons required to take ICS-300 and ICS-400 will need to take IS-800.A. Emergency managers or personnel whose primary responsibility is emergency management must complete this training.
