## Secure Your Load For Safer Roads....

### It's The Law!

#### What is an unsecured load?

An unsecured load is anything in transit that has not been fastened or attached to the vehicle. Tarps, rope, straps, netting, chains, and/or cargo bars may be used to prevent any part of the load or the covering from becoming loose, detached, or leaving the vehicle while it is moving.



#### How to secure your load:

- **Tie down.** Use rope, bungee cords, netting or straps. Tie larger items directly to your vehicle.
- **Lighter goes lower.** Put lighter items at the bottom of the load, and weigh them down so they don't blow out.
- **Don't overload.** Keep material level with truck bed or trailer if at all possible.

- **Double-check.** Always double-check your load. Ask yourself, "Would I feel safe driving behind my vehicle? If the answer is, "No," then you need to do a better job of securing your load.

#### Did You Know?

- In 2024 unsecured loads were responsible for 337 crashes and 32 injuries in Washington.
- Ecology and WSDOT collected more than 6.4 million pounds of litter in 2024, which is only a fraction of the 26 million pounds accumulating along roadways each year. Nearly 40% of that litter comes from items falling or blowing out of vehicles.
- Fines for failing to secure a load range from \$50 to \$5,000, with higher penalties for any incidents that result in injury or property damage. Criminal charges may apply in serious cases.

## Descriptions & Information ....

#### Appliances:

Include washers, dryers, metal dishwashers, water heaters, freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, wine and water coolers.

#### Construction/Demo/Bulky:

Includes wood/lumber, wood shingles, windows, insulation, carpet, toilets, tubs, cabinets, and bulky items such as furniture.

#### E-cycle:

TV's, computers, monitors, laptops, tablets & eReaders are accepted free, see an attendant before unloading.

#### Hazardous Waste, Business:

Accepted by appointment only, please call 360-678-8215.

#### Hazardous Waste, Household:

Household hazardous waste is accepted free of charge. Includes: Batteries, motor oil, oil-bases paints, antifreeze, gasoline, fertilizers, pesticides, acids, bases, fluorescent bulbs, lead, PBC ballasts, propane tanks, mercury devices, etc. Notify an attendant if you have household hazardous waste.

#### Municipal Solid Waste (MSW):

Regular household garbage, includes scrap sheet rock and 3-tab shingles.

#### Oversized, Hard to Handle:

Items that are over 6 feet such as mattresses, lumber, couches, trailers, boats, etc. Call 360-679-7387 in advance to arrange disposal of campers, trailers or boats. A title is required.

#### Yard Waste:

Yard waste is only accepted at the Coupeville Transfer Station and includes grass clippings, brush, and trees branches. No dirt, sod, or rock.

## Bayview and North Whidbey Solid Waste & Recycle Centers Restrictions....

These two locations accept extremely limited amounts of construction debris, metal, & yard waste. They cannot accept appliances or items greater than 4 feet. Attendants will direct customers with these materials to the Coupeville Transfer Station or recommend other appropriate disposal options.
