Proposal – Installation of new stormwater tightlines, catch basin, and outfall. Aspects of the proposed development will be located within the sideyard setback. Site is in or near: Steep Slopes, Unstable slopes, flood hazard areas, feeder bluff, and shoreline designation.

Island County has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a determination of non-significance (DNS). The optional DNS process established by WAC 197-11-355 is being used. The determination is based on the following findings and conclusions: We will be requesting that the applicant use best-management practices when installing, and to improve the shoreline jurisdiction that the BSA addendum report identifies as being degraded.
