22       (iv)    Possess any firearm or other dangerous weapon if previously ordered by a Court.

- While on Furlough / Temporary Release, a defendant who drives a motor vehicle must:
  - (i) Have a valid Washington driver's license in his or her possession.
  - (ii) Have the owner's written permission to drive any vehicle not his or her own, or his or her spouse's.
  - (iii) Have the minimum insurance required by the law
  - (iv) Observe all traffic laws.
