- ☐ Is subject to prosecution for escape pursuant to RCW 9A.76 if he/she fails to return to the designated institution at the designated time.

☐ Shall remain in the legal custody of _____ until release, termination or the end of the ordered period.

☐ While on Furlough / Temporary Release, the defendant must not:

(i) Violate the laws of any jurisdiction (Federal, State, or local)

(ii) Purchase, sell, possess, use, consume or administer any narcotic drugs, marijuana, alcohol, or intoxicants in any form or frequent any place where such articles are lawfully or unlawfully sold, dispensed, used or given away.

(iii) Use medication that is not prescribed and given to the defendant by a licensed physician or medical department.

(iv) Possess any firearm or other dangerous weapon if previously ordered by a Court.

☐ While on Furlough / Temporary Release, a defendant who drives a motor vehicle must:

- (i) Have a valid Washington driver's license in his or her possession.
- (ii) Have the owner's written permission to drive any vehicle not his or her own, or his or her spouse's.
- (iii) Have the minimum insurance required by the law
- (iv) Observe all traffic laws.
