



Epidemiology Brief: August 2020

Sex at birth was majority male.




20-39 year olds were the largest age group.



Compared to data from July, for the month of August the number of new lab confirmed COVID-19 cases has decreased. During August 2020, COVID-19 incidence was highest in persons aged 20–39 years, accounting for 45% of all confirmed cases, an increase from the July rate of 39%. The age distribution also aligns with the geographic distribution of confirmed COVID-19 for the month of August, with higher incidence among Oak Harbor residents. The majority of cases identified Island County as the geographic region for exposure, with three originating in other states, two originating in other counties, and one originating internationally. These findings underscore the importance of staying local and practicing preventative measures while traveling in Island County and minimizing travel outside of Island County.
