ISLAND COUNTY COVID-19 Updated Community Guidance

February 18, 2021

Island County Public Health wants to make sure that the citizens of Island County have access to reliable guidance surrounding COVID-19. We update guidance weekly to help inform our community.

Numbers and data

At the time of this writing, Island County has 1,232 confirmed COVID-19 cases, including 25 deaths. At this time, antigen test results are not included in the confirmed case count, but they are tracked locally. A case rate of 87.24 cases per 100,000 was calculated for the two-week period of 1/31/21-2/13/21.

Vaccine Status

Due to weather in the Midwest, vaccine distribution will be delayed this week. Please be patient with your providers and community partners until more vaccines arrive. We will keep you updated as we get information.

This week, Washington State will be focusing on boosters (2nd doses) versus Primary doses.

Appointments to get a first dose of COVID-19 vaccine will be extremely limited in Washington state the week of Feb. 14, 2021.
