ISLAND COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE: EVENTS and SCHOOL CLOSURES

March 13, 2020

Island County Public Health wants to keep you as informed as possible about continuing developments surrounding novel coronavirus and our response within the county. Governor Jay Inslee announced new community strategies to minimize exposure to COVID-19 in a press conference this afternoon. In alignment with this announcement, Island County Public Health will now be following the Governor's mandates:

New Statewide Mandates

1. All social, spiritual, and recreational gatherings of more than 250 people are prohibited throughout the state.
2. All schools in the state will be closed (K-12, plus 2-year, 4-year, community and technical schools) **no later than Tuesday March 17th through April 24th** (unless extended).
3. Adult family homes are now under the same [directive](#) as nursing/assisted living homes.
