COVID-19 vaccination clinics slated for October

Island County Public Health Department's COVID Response team has scheduled several vaccination clinics for this month.

The free clinics are open to people ages 12 and older. No ID or insurance information is required to receive a vaccine. Translation services will be available at the clinics, which are scheduled for the following times and dates:

- **3-7 p.m. Friday Oct. 8** at the Blue Fox Drive-in Theater, 1403 Monroe Landing Road, Oak Harbor;
- **11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday Oct. 14** at Island Thrift, 600 SE Barrington Drive, Oak Harbor, and;
- **2-7 p.m. Monday Oct. 25** at Skagit Valley College Whidbey Island Campus in Oak Harbor, Oak Hall, Main Lobby.

Priority at the vaccination clinics remains on first and second doses of the Johnson and Johnson Janssen, Moderna and Pfizer vaccines. Available on a limited basis will be third doses or boosters of COVID-19 vaccines for eligible patients as specified by the Washington State Department of Health.

For second and third doses and boosters, proof of prior vaccination for COVID-19 must be provided at the clinic. To receive a third dose, an attestation form also must be completed and signed.

Booster doses are also widely available at many medical providers and pharmacies in Island County and can be found by using the vaccine locator at <https://vaccinelocator.doh.wa.gov/> To find out dates and times for future mobile vaccination clinics, go to Island County Public Health's COVID resources page at <https://www.islandcountywa.gov/Health/Pages/COVID-19.aspx>
