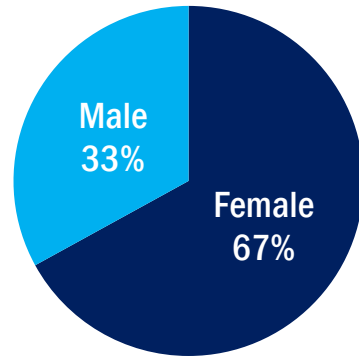


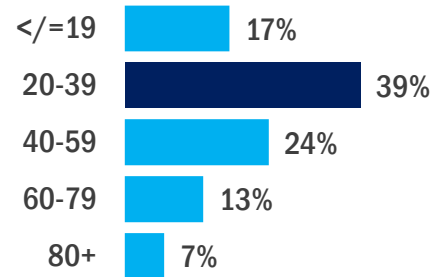

Sex at birth was majority female.

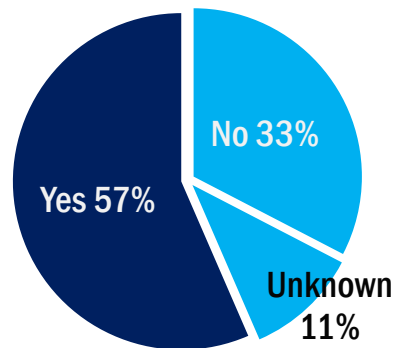


20-39 year olds were the largest age group.

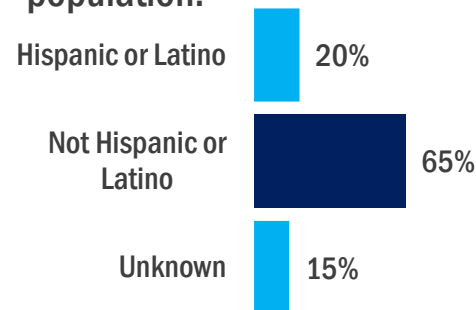

Compared to data from May and June, for the month of July the number of new lab confirmed COVID-19 cases has increased. During July 2020, COVID-19 incidence was highest in persons aged 20–39 years, accounting for 39% of all confirmed cases. Compared to early in the pandemic, when COVID-19 incidence was highest among older adults. The age distribution also aligns with the geographic distribution of confirmed COVID-19 for the month of July, with higher incidence among Oak Harbor residents. In Oak Harbor over 30% of residents are between the ages of 20 and 34 years, compared to 12% in Coupeville; 11% in Langley; and 12% in Camano Island. These findings underscore the importance of preventive measures (e.g., social distancing, respiratory hygiene, and wearing face coverings in public settings where social distancing measures are difficult to maintain).
