ELIGIBILITY IS FOR **ALL** TRICARE Beneficiaries 18 years and older!

NHCOH is currently providing the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine to ALL of their TRICARE beneficiaries, age 18 years and older. Vaccination appointments are for Active Duty and their Family Members as well as Retirees and Family Members of Retirees.

Moderna Vaccine Appointments available (NHCOH Immunizations Dept)

There are two avenues for beneficiaries to make an appointment:

- Patients can call PSMAC at 800-404-4506 to book a vaccine appointment. PSMAC hours are Mon – Fri: 6:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. and Sat/Sun: 7:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

If you are due for your 2nd dose of the Moderna COVID vaccine, please GET IT! To maximize your protection, especially against dangerous variant strains of the COVID virus, we strongly urge you to return to NHCOH for your 2nd dose as soon as possible. If you are coming for your 2nd dose, BRING YOUR CARD VERIFYING YOU RECEIVED YOUR FIRST DOSE

TESTING

Have COVID symptoms or need a COVID Test?

Our process to be evaluated for any COVID symptoms / Cold symptoms / Flu symptoms:
Call our centralized booking resource PSMAC: 1-800-404-4506 or the Nurse Advice Line (NAL) 1-800-874-2273 they will book you an appointment to speak to an RN who will assist you with an in-person appointment, COVID testing or both.

Remember, for COVID testing, we only call you back with POSITIVE test results (Due to increased demand for testing, it may take 5 days for any results - positive or negative.) Once received, your test results can be seen in your MHS GENESIS Patient Portal.
