STATEMENT REGARDING COVID-19 TESTING (CORONAVIRUS)

Island County, May 19, 2020:

On May 18, Island County Public Health expanded COVID-19 testing to all Island County residents over 18 years of age. Due to tremendous community participation on this first day of testing and limited testing supplies, Island County Public Health is cancelling testing in Oak Harbor on Wednesday, May 19. **All other testing dates and locations remain the same.** Please take note that today, May 19 is the final opportunity for community members planning to visit the Oak Harbor mobile testing site. Below are the testing dates, locations, and times for the remainder of the week:

Date	Location	Hours
Tuesday, May 19	Oak Harbor High School	11am – 7pm
Wednesday, May 20	Utsalady Elementary, Camano Island	3pm – 8pm
Thursday, May 21	South Whidbey High School	11am – 7pm

There is no out-of-pocket cost for this viral PCR test, but insurance information will be collected if available. Please bring a photo ID and insurance card if you have health insurance. Testing takes place in a drive-thru fashion. For shorter wait times, please consider coming towards the middle to the end of the testing hours.
