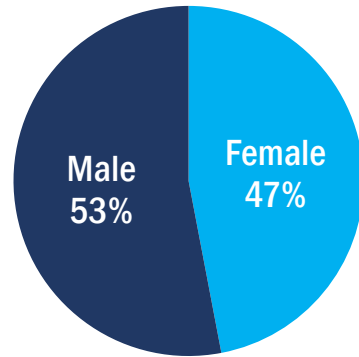


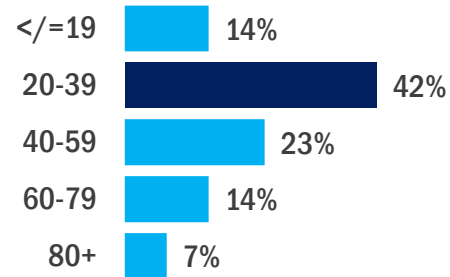

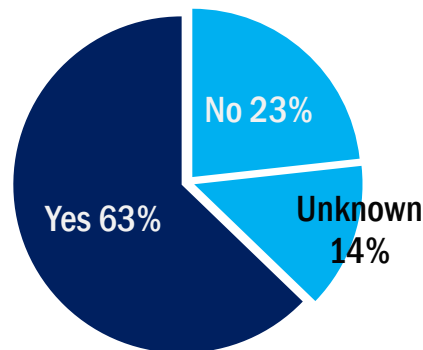
Sex at birth was majority male.



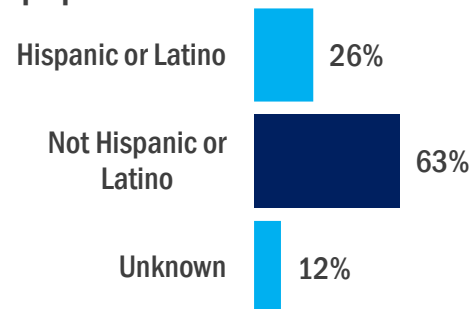
20-39 year olds were the largest age group.

Compared to data from August, in September, the number of new lab confirmed COVID-19 cases has increased. For the month of September 2020, COVID-19 demographic trends remained similar to those from July & August, with higher incidence: among 20-39 year olds, in Oak Harbor, and among Hispanic/Latino's in greater proportion than the total population percentage. In addition, in the month of September as the new school year approached, school districts became increasingly interested in the COVID-19 case rates. For the first three weeks of September the Island County two week case rate ranged from 20.04 cases per 100,000 residents to 38.91 cases per 100,000 residents. In September, five (12%), of the total case count for the month were for individuals birth to 18 years of age. These findings suggest that while transmission is possible in school age children, COVID-19 transmission prevention efforts across Island County should remain focused on the youth and young adults under the age of 40 years.
