Whidbey Health Medical Clinic

Anyone can be tested, regardless of symptoms, if any. If no symptoms and just wanting “piece of mind” or if the test is need for travel, results are not guaranteed to be in 72hours, a fee of **\$150.00** will be charged to each person.

For those with more significant symptoms that cannot be managed at home, register for testing, or seek medical attention at the Emergency Room (Medical Center, Coupeville)

Whidbey Health Medical Center (Coupeville ONLY)

Advance registration is required to prevent waiting lines, help schedule adequate staff, and manage inventory of PPE and supplies.

Referral required if test is requested by a Dr. for: Pre-op, Out-patient surgery, or any other medical procedure.

Call [360-240-4055](tel:360-240-4055) *Option 5*, to arrange your appointment or follow the prompt to leave your name, phone number, and birth date, for them to call you back.

Drive thru ONLY:

Mondays, Tuesdays & Thursdays 10am to 3:50pm. CLOSED from 1 – 1:30 for Lunch break.

Wednesdays and Fridays from 8:00am to 12:00pm.

PCR testing performed, sent to the lab, and results usually in 3 to 5 days, may take longer with higher volume.

They call on Positive test and Negative results can be accessed via the patient portal.

Should have symptoms. Booking is two (2) days out. (scheduler opens at 7pm for the next day)

Results – Rapid Antigen – Approx. 24 Hrs. e-mailed (*Not Valid for all Travel*)

PCR – Approx. 48 -72 Hrs. e-mailed (**Valid for Travel**)

This is a Primary Care Physicians office. You will need to become a patient of the office to be tested.

Tuesdays and Fridays only. 8:00-12:00 & 1:00 -4:00.

PCR - Approximately 2 to 3 days. **Valid for travel**.

Skagit County: Please check with a Pharmacy or at your Physician clinic.
