Activities in Island County may involve review and permitting by the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR). Please use this screening tool to determine if DNR review is needed for your proposal.

Please contact the Washington State DNR Northwest Region Office at (360) 856-3500 or [bud.wescott@dnr.wa.gov](mailto:bud.wescott@dnr.wa.gov) if ANY of the following circumstances apply:

- Proposal is within 200-feet of a Type F stream.
- Within 50-feet of a non-fish Type Np or Ns stream.
- Within 100-feet of a wetland.
- "Forest land" refers to all land capable of supporting a merchantable stand of timber unless current use is incompatible with timber growing. Activities on forest land involve DNR review if the following apply:
  - Proposal is in the vicinity of unstable slopes.
  - In vicinity of "Critical Wildlife Habitat" for listed species defined by WDFW/USFWS.
  - Proposal requires Hydraulic Project Approval (HPA) from the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW).
  - Planning to harvest greater than 5,000 board feet on parcel that is 2 acres or more of contiguous ownership.
  - Planning to sell any amount of timber that will be harvested from a parcel 2 acres or more of contiguous ownership.
  - 600 feet or greater of road construction for parcels 2 acres or more of contiguous ownership.
