

NOTICE of APPLICATION with SEPA - REPUBLICATION

Island County has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a determination of non-significance (DNS). The optional DNS process established by WAC 197-11-355 is being used. **The public comment period as described below may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the following proposal.**

Proposal: Remove existing concrete boat launch, replace with pre-cast concrete boat launch, articulated concrete mats, install “L” shaped boat loading float; asphalt pave existing gravel parking lot, add ADA parking & improve road entrance. Variance to exceed the 5-foot maximum width for docks & floats to meet ADA requirements. **Site is in or near:** Wetland, Lake Shoreline Jurisdiction, mapped stream, & Flood zone.
