Project Benefits

Piping the stormwater that passes under Sunset Drive at the project location will mitigate flooding to the parcels to the west of the road. The project will also reduce stormwater infiltrating into the bluff and running uncontrolled over the bluff, which are contributing factors to bluff erosion.

Costs are in 2016 dollars.



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Project Description

Island County Public Works proposes to improve stormwater drainage which crosses under N Sunset Drive south of Spring Street.

The project proposes to pipe stormwater from Sunset Drive to the toe of the bluff on Saratoga Passage. The project will construct a HDPE pipe bluff outfall to convey stormwater down an approximately 140 foot high bluff.
