### CURRENT YEAR PROPERTY TAX PAYMENT PLAN AGREEMENT

*RCW 84.56.020(15)(b)(i) allows the treasurer of a county, at their discretion, to enter into payment agreements with taxpayers for the payment of current year taxes.*

\_\_\_\_\_, (Taxpayer), agrees to pay the **Island County Treasurer** (Treasurer), \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (2020 annual property tax amount) including an initial sum of at least 25% of the amount due by April 30 and a \$35 setup fee, plus 1% accruing interest, according to the payment schedule attached as "Exhibit A" to this document. The payment schedule requires that payments be made timely each month in recognition that Taxpayer will pay off the remaining balance by December 31, 2020.

Treasurer must receive each payment **on or before** the indicated due date; postmark is not sufficient. Payments will be applied to the outstanding balance as deemed appropriate by Treasurer. It is Taxpayer's responsibility to notify Treasurer **in writing** of any pending court action that may affect Taxpayer's ability to make the next scheduled payment. This includes any current and new bankruptcy proceedings.

It is the responsibility of Taxpayer to make payments according to the schedule. Treasurer will **NOT** send out monthly reminders or delinquent notices. If any payment is not received as scheduled, if a payment is returned by the bank, or the final payment is not made by December 31, 2020, immediate termination of the Agreement will result and statutory penalty and interest will be reinstated. All monies paid during the Agreement will be retained by Island County and applied towards unpaid property taxes on the above account.

Treasurer agrees to suspend all collection efforts to recover the delinquent sum until the payment plan is completely paid off. Failure to comply with payment terms will result in termination of this Agreement and collection efforts will recommence.

If this Agreement is terminated or cancelled in any way prior to its completion, Taxpayer will be disqualified from the current year property tax payment plan program for two calendar years following the date of cancellation. Taxpayer may request a new plan after the time period has expired.

Nothing in this Agreement prevents Taxpayer from paying more than the scheduled monthly amount or paying off the entire delinquent balance plus accrued interest before the end of the payment plan. Upon complete payment of the delinquent balance plus accrued interest, Treasurer will provide notice to Taxpayer that the delinquent balance is satisfied.

By signing this Agreement, Taxpayer agrees to adhere to the provisions set forth in this document and the attached payment schedule. Treasurer is offering to enter into this Agreement with the understanding that Taxpayer is requesting special payment arrangements as described above. To accept this offer, Taxpayer must sign and return two copies of this Agreement to Treasurer with the initial payment. Taxpayer must submit the first payment and setup fee at the same time. A copy signed by Treasurer and a receipt for the first payment will be returned once the payment has been processed.

If the Agreement is not signed and returned with the first payment before April 30, 2020, the offer to enter into this Agreement will expire and Taxpayer must contact Treasurer’s office to make alternate payment arrangements.
